## PubMed Literature Search:

### Basic Search Strategy

- Boolean operators ("AND", "OR", "NOT")
- Wildcard ("\*")
- Search Field Tags (e.g. [au] means "author",
  "Rutherford[au]")
  - Filters

## **Boolean Operators**

#### 3 operators:

- -AND, OR, NOT
- -Must be <u>CAPITALIZED</u>
- -Lowercase operators (ex. "and", "or", "not") will all be replaced with "AND"
- Order of terms is crucial
- -Quotes group phrases together:

diabetes mellitus phototherapy = diabetes mellitus AND phototherapy \* "diabetes mellitus phototherapy"





## "OR" (Boolean operator)

### Ex. football OR hockey OR soccer

Search terms	Results
football	4819
hockey	1058
soccer	2517
football OR hockey OR soccer	6090








# "NOT" (Boolean operator)

#### Ex. arthritis NOT letter

Search terms	Results
arthritis	167,933
letter	617,646
arthritis NOT letter	159,681









## "AND" (Boolean operator)

## Ex. salmonella AND hamburger

Search terms	Results
salmonella	64810
hamburger	2494
salmonella AND hamburger	12




"AND" is PubMed's default operator. If you do not use Boolean operators in the search, PubMed automatically uses "AND" between terms





# Comprehensive Search using Wildcard "\*"

- Type: "prevent\*"
- -Finds articles with the words:
  - -prevention
  - -preventative
  - -preventable, etc.
- Type: "diarrh\*"
- -Finds articles with the words:
  - -diarrhea
  - -diarrhoea
  - -diarrheal
  - -diarrhoeal, etc.





## Search Field Tags

#### Helpful tags (also appear in Advanced Search):

[au].....author

[ti].....title

[tiab]....title/abstract

[tw].....text words

#### Examples:

Microbicides[ti] OR HIV[tw]





# Using "Filters" in PubMed

-Time filter	in the past 7 years or past 7 days?
-Sex filter	only female or male subjects?
-Language filter	only in English or Vietnamese?
-Age filter	only infant subjects?
-Article type	only randomized control trials?
-Subjects filter	only AIDS? Cancer?
